Introduction:

One of the most challenging parts of learning to play the guitar is the rhythmic aspect of it. *Why is that?* Well if you think about it, there are three rhythms happening at the same time when you are leading worship or singing and playing your guitar. First off, your right hand is strumming one rhythm, your left hand is chording a second rhythm (the timing of your chord



changes), and thirdly, you are singing a vocal phrasing rhythm. A big part of learning to play the guitar is connecting those three rhythms together. The goal is for your hands to become so used to the chords and rhythm, that is becomes second nature. This will in turn set you free to sing the way you want, while playing what you need to.

What are Keys?

Not keys for doors! A Key is a family of **7 different notes** that all harmonize with each other. There are 12 keys that you can actually play in based on our western scale of music which is made up of half steps and whole steps.

What Keys should I learn?

Most guitar players play in about **5 keys** comfortably. When I say comfortably, I mean that they are typically chords that don't require a lot of bar chords and difficult fingering.



The **5 keys** that most guitar players play in especially when learning are **C**, **D**, **E**, **G**, and **A**. Each one of those keys are made up of **7 notes** that also have **7 corresponding chords**. For example, If you learn the **7 chords** in the chord family of the key of D, you can play almost any song in that key.

What is a Chord Family?

A chord family is made up of **7 chords** that all have a relationship to each other, based on the key that you are playing in.

For Example; In the key of D you have... o I II III IV V VI VII o **D, Em, F#m, G, A, Bm, A/C#**

Why do I need to learn chord families?

If you learn the 7 chords in each family (C, D, E, G, and A), you will be able to play any song in those keys.

What's that little squeezy thing (Capo)?

Capo's are one of the guitar player's best friends.

A Capo gives you the ability to play in the same fingering of a key that you like, but to be able to raise the key up a half step every time you move your capo up one fret towards the sound hole.

For example: if I really like playing a song in the key of D using the 7 chords in the chord family of D, but I find that the song is a bit



low. Because I REALLY like using the D chord shapes and fingering in that particular song, I can place my Capo on fret 1 which sharps the key a half step, and I am now playing in the key of Eb. If I placed my Capo in the 2nd fret because I wanted to play the song even higher but still use the chord family of D because I like the voicing of those chords, I am now actually playing in the key of E because we have now sharped our guitar a whole step up from D. Check out the chart to help understand.

The Names of the Strings

The six strings of a guitar are numbered from 1 to 6 starting on the thinnest string and counting up to the thickest string. I know backwards right?

The strings also have letter names or notes that correspond to each string when it's played open, or by The itself. open-tuned notes from string the largest string to the smallest are E, A, D, G, B and E.



Memorize the names of your strings.


Your guitar will need to be tuned before playing. Tuning involves tightening or loosening the strings to raise or lower the pitch to match a constant pitch. USUALLY, not always, tuners will change the pitch UP by turning the knobs to the left or counter-clockwise and changing the pitch down by turning right or clockwise.

There are three main ways to tune your guitar. You can tune your guitar by using an electronic tuner, or you can tune by "ear" using the other strings of the guitar, or you can tune to a keyboard.






How to Read Chord Blocks

CHORD BLOCKS are diagrams that tell you how a chord is to be played. They include information about which frets are to be played by which fingers and which strings are to be played or not.


The fret hand fingers are numbered in a standard way so you can easily know what finger to place on what string. The pointer finger is "1", the middle finger is "2", the ring finger is "3", and the pinky is "4". The thumb is often referred to as "T".

In the grid illustration below you can see all six strings are shown vertically from the Low E to the High E. The grid looks like the actual neck of the guitar. The frets

run horizontal and are numbered in order starting with the 1st fret, 2nd fret, 3rd fret, and so on. Notice the thick horizontal line at the top of the grid. This is called the nut and is not considered a fret.




At first you will be spending a lot of time within the first five frets working on open position chords, or chords played with at least one open string. These open position chords are the first chords that just about every guitar player learns when they first start to learn guitar.
